# 100 Marathon Club Major Changes Announced





### 2001–2021: 100 MARATHON CLUB NORTH AMERICA

Bob and Lenore Dolphin were a very busy couple in early 2001. Bob was methodically pounding pavement on his way to ultimately finishing over 500 marathons, while Lenore continued to serve as a tireless volunteer at all of Bob's races. Billed as "the world's oldest marathon race directors," Bob and Lenore were working closely with other Hard Core Running Club members preparing for the inaugural Yakima River Canyon Marathon. With input and encouragement from Roger Biggs, then president of the British 100 Marathon Club, Bob and Lenore founded, funded, launched, and promoted the 100 Marathon Club North America. Club membership has slowly grown to 675+ individuals.

While club membership has grown during the past 21 years, little else has changed. Membership has always been free because Bob and Lenore personally funded all club expenses. The membership list has evolved to become an on-line roster that is woefully out-of-date because few members have ever submitted updated information. Club newsletters grew from periodic EMail messages into monthly on-line editions, but few members read them. Members have steadily requested shirts, hats, jackets, pins, other products, and club benefits that have never been created. The few volunteers maintaining the roster, authoring newsletters, preparing and distributing finisher certificates, serving as webmaster, and donating hosting for the club's web pages have all helped maintain the club on life support.

#### 2022: 100 MARATHON CLUB NORTH AMERICA

With Lenore's passing in early 2020 and Bob's passing in late 2021, the 100 Marathon Club North America is at a major crossroads. Although the worldwide pandemic during the past two years has significantly decreased marathon-related activities, the pandemic has also provided an opportunity to fully evaluate our club's current situation. As a result we are introducing what we believe is a beneficial and logical evolutionary leap forward that will continue to honor Bob and Lenore's vision while breathing new life into the club.

Many 100 Marathon Club North America members also belong to the Marathon Maniacs. During the past 20+ years the Marathon Maniacs organization has grown exponentially and is on track to soon register the 16,000<sup>th</sup> Maniac. This stellar growth is a direct result of continuing to focus on identifying and delivering an extensive array of membership benefits. Rather than spending years attempting to reinvent a similar smorgasbord of benefits from scratch, we have opted to merge the 100 Marathon Club North America directly into the Marathon Maniac organization, creating a highly desirable achievement and recognition level known as the "100 Marathon Club of the Americas."
